LAST FOR DECADES.

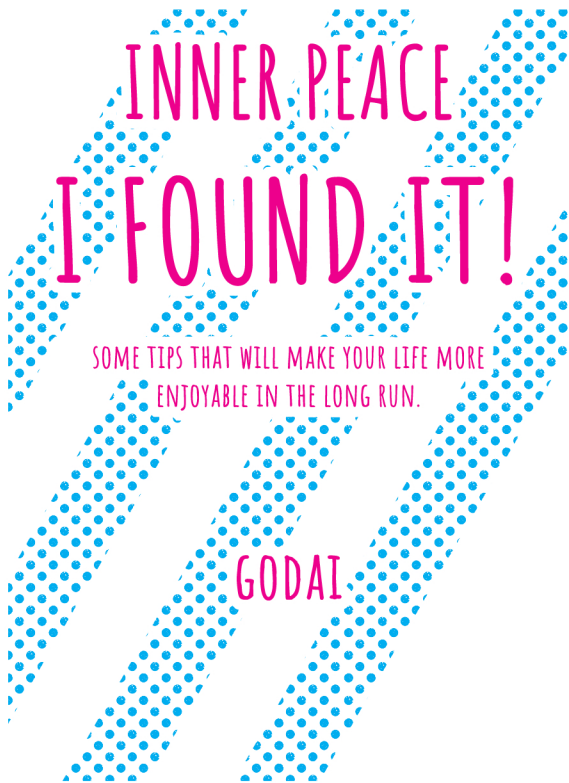
THESE ARE JUST SMALL STEPS AND IT WILL
